



## **COVID TESTING**

The cash price for COVID Testing is as follows:

### **THE TEST:**

Rapid Antigen Test (RAT): \$89

PCR Test (PCR): \$125

Antibody Test (AB): \$95

### **PROFESSIONAL FEES (Physician Services):**

Additional fees will apply for professional physician services and will vary depending on the reason and complexity of the visit. For example, for patients without symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, new loss of taste or smell, vomiting or diarrhea, and/or sore throat.), and who are unexposed to a person who may have COVID, the professional fee will be \$76. Whereas, for patients with symptoms, or for patients who have been exposed to a person who may have COVID, the professional fee will range from \$168 to \$371. Such professional fees are in addition to the cash price of the COVID test listed above. If you indicate you have no symptoms, but it is determined that you need a physician consultation because of one or more symptoms, the higher fee range will apply.

### **OTHER FEES:**

Other fees may apply based on patient needs (i.e. other lab tests, breathing treatments, X-rays, and after-hours fee etc.).

### **INSURANCE:**

#### **In Network:**

For patients who have insurance plans that are contracted with Texas MedClinic (i.e. are **In-Network**), Texas MedClinic will bill your insurance plan and there should be no charge to you for the COVID test. If your insurance applies a patient cost sharing (even though the Cares Act Disallows this), we will apply that amount towards your responsibility.

#### **Out of Network or No Insurance:**

For patients who have no insurance or have insurance plans that are **NOT** contracted with Texas MedClinic (i.e. Out of Network), we will not bill your insurance plan and you will be required to pay for the COVID test, professional fees, and other fees in full at the time of service. You will receive a receipt that you can turn in to your carrier. Under no circumstances will a refund be provided regardless of the Explanation of Benefits (EOB) that you receive from your insurance plan. A cash discount will apply for balances paid in full at the time of service.
